

## QUESTIONS:

Start by reading chapter 24 together.

1. What is the main idea of this passage?
2. What stands out to you from this passage and/or the sermon from Sunday?
3. Read Isaiah 24:2: Isaiah describes a leveling of society's power structures. Do you think Christians treat different classes of people differently?
  - a. Should God's equal judgment impact the way we interact with the lost? How?
4. Read verse 5: God's punishment is caused by the people's wickedness. We still see that type of wickedness today. Why do Christians have a responsibility to confront sin in the world?
  - a. In what ways can you personally confront sin in the world?
  - b. Do you think Christians have become too comfortable with sin around us? What is your evidence?
5. Read verse 11: How could you use this verse in sharing the Gospel? Would you? Do you have a "go-to" verse or passage for sharing the Gospel?
6. Comparing and contrasting verses 7-13 with verses 14-16: the worship of Christians is naturally evangelistic. Agree or disagree. And why?
  - a. Should we consider inviting people to church evangelism?
  - b. Do you have people you can invite to church? Could our LifeGroup pray for them to accept your invitation?
