Start by reading chapter 25 together.

1. What is the main idea of this passage?
2. What stands out to you from this passage and/or the sermon from Sunday?
3. Read Isaiah 25:1: Isaiah says that God's wonderful accomplishments were "plans formed of old." In a word, this is faithfulness. How does God's faithfulness bring His people joy?
 - a. What are some ways that you remind yourself of God's faithfulness during difficult times?
4. Read Isaiah 25:4: Is this statement still true today? How is it true?
 - a. How have you seen God use His Church for this purpose?
5. Read 25:8: The image of a feast and God wiping away tears gives us a glimpse of our future with Him. How does this future hope shape our priorities and relationships today?
 - a. How does God's promise to "swallow up death forever" influence how we handle fear?
6. Read verse 9: How do we practically wait on God today? How can we stay joyful in our waiting?
7. After studying Isaiah 25, name a specific area in your life where you need to depend on God more fully. How can you actively pursue that this week?
